



EVRIONTA COOKIE POLICY

Last updated: 25 march 2026

Preamble

EVRIONTA is concerned with the privacy of the EVRIONTA platform (the "Platform") users, and uses its best efforts to protect it. In particular, EVRIONTA undertakes to ensure a level of protection of personal data that is in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), including any regulations implementing, complementing or replacing the GDPR, where appropriate.

By means of cookies and other tracers, EVRIONTA collects and processes personal data relating to the Members. "Members" means the users, who have both registered and not registered with the Platform.

This Cookie policy (the "Cookie Policy") describes how the personal data of Members will be collected, by means of cookies and other tracers, and how these data will be processed.

1. Definition of Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit websites. They are widely used to ensure websites function properly, to enhance user experience, and to provide analytical data to website operators.

Cookies may be "session cookies" (which are deleted when you close your browser) or "persistent cookies" (which remain stored on your device for a defined period or until you delete them).

The file may only be read by its issuer, i.e. EVRIONTA. The file, during its duration of validity, enables its issuer to recognise the device used, every time this device is used to access content that includes cookies placed by that issuer.

Cookies enable EVRIONTA to store information on how the Members browse the Platform and how it navigates through the Platform.

In accordance with applicable laws, and save for exceptions, EVRIONTA will ask the Members for their consent before placing these cookies.

2. Types of Cookies Used

EVRIONTA uses the following categories of cookies:

2.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Platform and cannot be disabled. They are typically set in response to actions made by you, such as logging in, filling out forms, or setting privacy preferences.

2.2 Functional Cookies

These cookies enable the Platform to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have integrated into our Platform.

2.3 Performance and Analytical Cookies

These cookies allow us to collect information about how users interact with the Platform, including the number of visitors, the pages visited, and traffic sources. This information helps us improve the performance and usability of the Platform.

2.4 Targeting and Advertising Cookies

These cookies may be set through our Platform by advertising partners to build a profile of your interests and deliver relevant advertisements on other websites. They do not store directly identifiable personal data, but they are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device.

2.5 Third-Party Cookies

We may allow third-party service providers to place cookies on your device for the purposes described above. These providers may include analytics companies and advertising networks. EVRIONTA does not know which cookies are used by these third party websites. The use of cookies by third parties is subject to their own privacy policies and not this Cookie Policy.

3. Purposes of Cookie Collection

EVRIONTA uses cookies for the following purposes:

- To ensure the proper technical functioning of the Platform;
- To enhance and personalise the Member's user experience;
- To remember Member's preferences and settings;
- To analyse Platform performance and usage statistics;
- To detect and prevent fraudulent or abusive activity;
- To deliver relevant content and targeted advertising;

To comply with legal and regulatory obligations where applicable. All cookies are collected and processed in accordance with applicable data protection laws and the provisions of this Cookie Policy.

4. Legal Basis for the Use of Cookies

Upon first access to the Platform, the Members will be presented with a cookie banner, which enables the Members to provide or refuse consent for the use of non-essential cookies. This banner allows for granular control, offering the Members the ability to:

- Accept all cookies;
- Reject all non-essential cookies;
- Customise cookie preferences by category.

Consent is obtained through a clear and affirmative action by the Members. EVRIONTA ensures that the mechanism for providing consent is as easily accessible and user-friendly as the mechanism for withdrawing it.

The Members may at any time modify or withdraw their consent by accessing the cookie settings on the Platform or adjusting the settings in their browser. EVRIONTA maintains appropriate records of consent in accordance with applicable legal obligations.

5. Who are the recipients of the data collected through the cookies?

The data collected through the cookies that are strictly necessary to supply the service at the Member's request, will not be disclosed to third parties, except to the Platform hosting service provider which stores all of the data.

The data relating to performance, to audience measurement, and to conversion tracking, may be used by EVRIONTA or by a third party. The recipients of the data collected by means of the cookies are: Google, Inspectlet, Facebook, LinkedIn, and Pinterest, each recipient receiving the data that concern it.

- The data collected through the cookies may also be disclosed to individuals authorised by EVRIONTA to process these data, and who have first signed a non-disclosure agreement, including to EVRIONTA employees;
- to EVRIONTA's external counsels and advisors: lawyers, accountants, statutory auditors, etc., which are bound by an obligation of secrecy;
- to authorities: in accordance with the law, further to an order from a court and/or further to a court ruling;

to any third party, in the event of a merger by way of acquisition, the assignment of all or part of assets, a direct or indirect change of control, or any other form of restructuring implemented by EVRIONTA.

6. Consent and Cookie Settings

Upon the Member's first visit to the Platform, they will be presented with a cookie banner requesting your consent to the use of non-essential cookies. The Members may withdraw their consent or modify their cookie preferences at any time by adjusting the settings in their browser or device.

Please note that disabling certain cookies may impact the functionality and performance of the Platform.

7. Managing Cookies

Members can control and delete cookies through your browser settings. Instructions for managing cookies in commonly used browsers are available at:

8. Cookie Retention Periods

Cookies placed on the Members's device are retained for a maximum period of thirteen (13) months from the date of their initial placement.

After this period, cookies are either deleted or renewed upon renewed consent.

The personal data collected through these cookies are retained for a maximum period of twenty-five (25) months, after which such data shall be either deleted or anonymised, unless a longer retention period is required under applicable laws or justified by a specific legal obligation.

9. Changes to This Cookie Policy

EVRIONTA reserves the right to amend this Cookie Policy at any time. The revised version shall be published on the Platform with an indication of the date of the last update.
